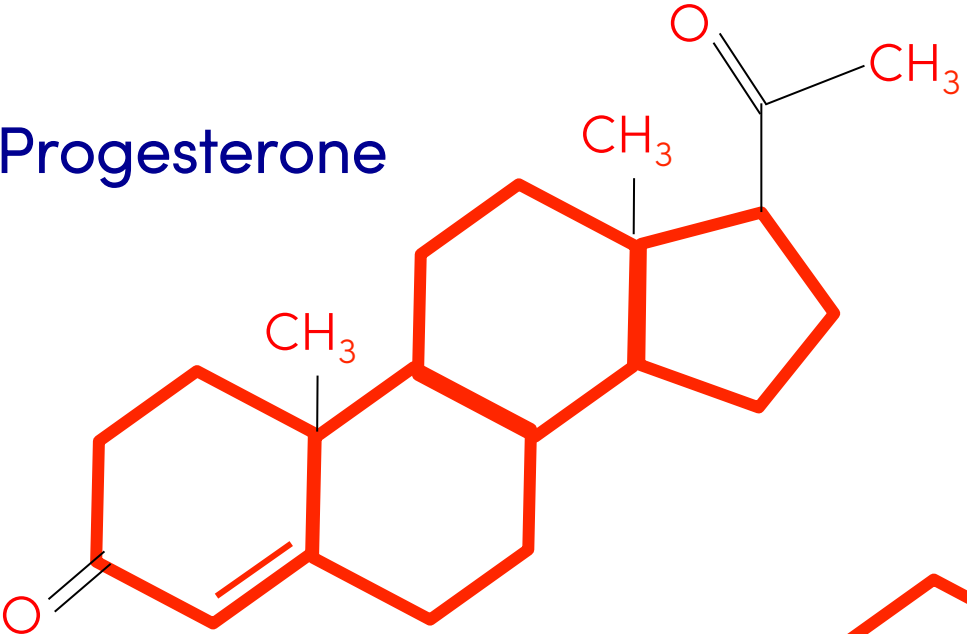
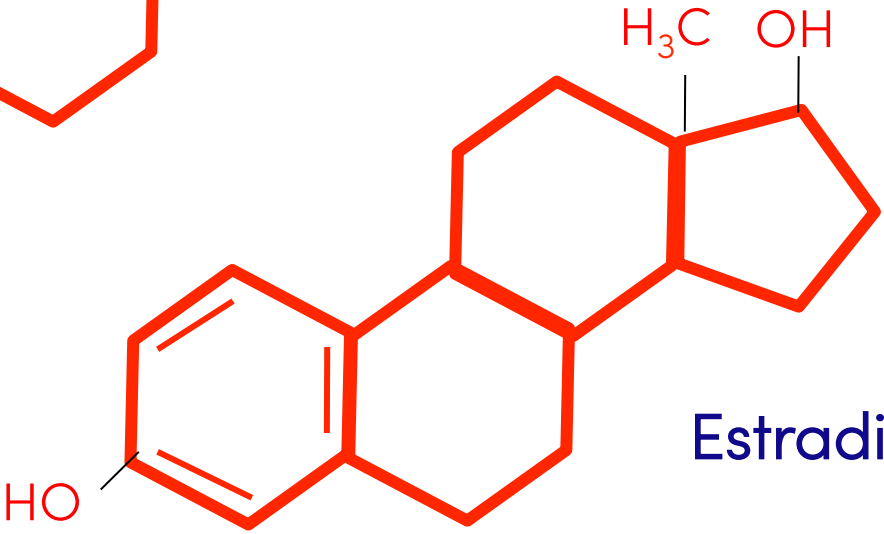

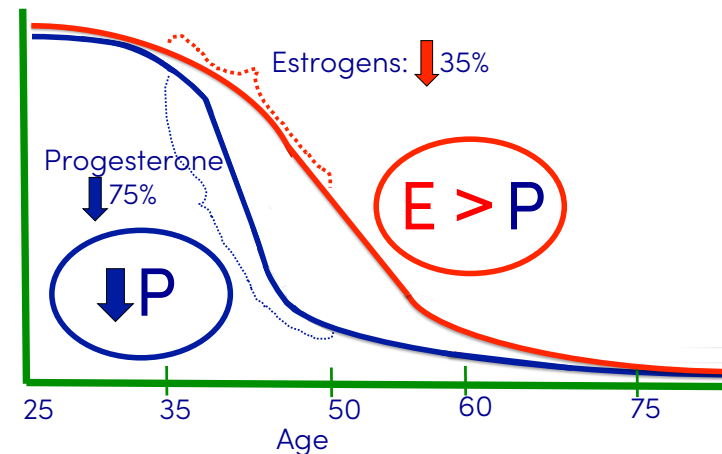

Age-chronologically, the first of the most common hormonal changes in a younger woman can easily be in her mid-thirties, with an earlier and more profound decline in progesterone

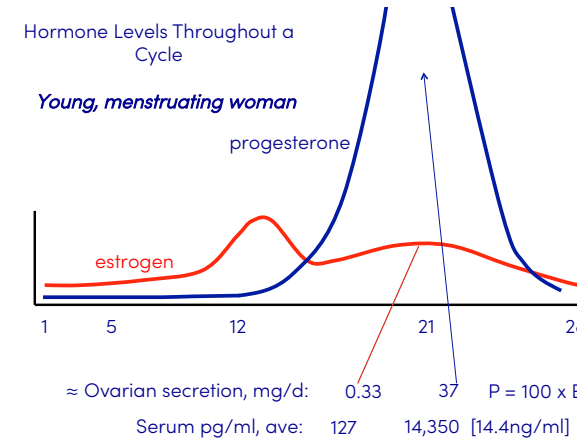
